The Program

The International Management (IM) degree is a two-year course designed for students wishing to play an active role in managerial processes typical of companies operating in a global scenario.

The course provides advanced training in the key areas of management and business administration in global contexts. A major strength of the program is the combination of strong analytical foundation and applications to real-world issues. Students will learn to integrate international management and innovation issues, as well as industry and economy-wide competences for understanding global changing organizations. Several teaching methods are used, including group project works, case studies, role-plays, and simulations.

Program type: Graduate degree/Master of Science - MSc ("Laurea Magistrale")

Course duration: 2-years

ECTS/Credit points: 120

Placement

IM program opens up a wide range of career opportunities. IM graduates have both the technical knowledge and the methodological tools suited to pursue professional and managerial careers in large corporation dealing with international and multicultural issues, as well as smaller and national companies implementing and managing international processes and strategies.

Curriculum

Students must earn at least 120 credits, including the 24 credits for the final exam (Final Dissertation), to graduate. Each student can personalize his/her own curriculum according to the following structure:

- Five elective courses of Business Management among: Business communication, Supply chain management, Corporate governance and social responsibility, International corporate finance, Cross cultural management, Project management, Performance measurement, Change management, Public management.
- Two elective courses of Business Economics among: Political economy of the European Union, Labor economics, Monetary economics and asset pricing, Political and public economics, Industrial organization, Microeconomics, Macroeconomics, Empirical economics.
- Mathematics for Economic Analysis.
- Transnational Commercial Law.
- Work and organizational psychology.
- One elective course among the above listed courses: Advanced business English, Advanced English TOEFL, Computational methods for the analysis of business and economic data, Internship.
- Final Dissertation

Entry requirements

- › Students need to hold an undergraduate degree, obtained after a minimum of 3 years of study (180 ECTS) and in a subject which is relevant to the chosen degree course.
- › UCSC will evaluate the student's academic and personal background and decide if the specific conditions for admission to the graduate degree are met.

Language prerequisite

TOEFL/IBT score of at least 80 or an Academic IELTS score of at least 6.0.

The English proficiency requirement is met for international applicants with degrees earned in English from accredited universities and colleges in the United States, Canada, United Kingdom, Australia, New Zealand or other English speaking countries.
